The Purpose of the Rating Committee:

- 1. To establish ratings for all PPC members to play in organized programs, clinics, ladders, round robins, and club tournaments with other players of similar abilities.
- 2. To use USAPA/IFP or PCO Skills and Ratings Descriptions (and PBC Ratings that may be developed & improved in the future).
- 3. To keep records of all PPC member ratings.
- 4. To agree to a set of standards and training for PPC members.
- 5. To set up a syntax for rating players as follows:
 - To be determined currently under review.

Notes:

- 1. If a player has a USA/PCO/PBC Tournament Rating based on Tournament play, this will serve as their official PPC Club Rating.
- 2. Self Ratings represent a member's critical self-evaluation of his or her skills.
- 3. The PPC reserves the right to determine the final Rating of a member involved in PPC Program play.
- 4. To establish a mechanism for Rating Changes. Any player may request a change in level. Changes may be completed in two ways.
- First, confirmed USAPA/PCO/PBC Tournament Play Ratings will be accepted for change purposes.
- Second involves the player making an application to the Rating Committee for a change through the Rating Sign-up. An Evaluation Session will be conducted in a separate arranged rating session and results will be forwarded to the Ratings Committee for review.
