

Meeting Highlights

Executive Meeting of the Penticton Pickleball Club (PPC) Executive
held on Wednesday, May 20, 2020

- 🗨️ Due to the COVID-19 pandemic this was a virtual meeting.
- 🗨️ **MOTION** carried that the executive supports the President signing the letter from the city for the construction of 2 new courts with the PPC's contribution of \$50,000.
- 🗨️ The city would like to publicly recognize the PPC for its contribution towards the 2 new courts.
- 🗨️ The PPC's **due diligence towards handling of the COVID-19 issue is imperative** to ensure our insurance policy remains effective.
- 🗨️ Due to changes in the PCO insurance policy from the former policy, and the recent COVID-19 pandemic, the liability waiver will require an update.
- 🗨️ All members will be required to sign the new waiver as soon as it is available.
- 🗨️ With the definition change of 'Guest' in the PCO policy, the guest waiver will need to accommodate record keeping for a guest's PCO number (if applicable) as well as the number of visits made to the courts by a non-PCO member as they are **limited to a total of 3 visits** maximum.
- 🗨️ The PPC currently has **160 members**.
- 🗨️ Due to the overwhelming success of the reintroduction to pickleball program it was agreed to continue with it beyond the 2-week timeline.
- 🗨️ A change for week 2 of the reintroduction will be to **allow groups of up to 6 players** (maximum of 5 attending any one session).
- 🗨️ Stressed the **importance of everyone following the COVID guidelines/restrictions**, specifically social distancing and use of the west entrance by players on courts 2 and 3.
- 🗨️ **A round of applause to Dave for his efforts to get the PPC members back on the courts!**
- 🗨️ The next PPC executive meeting will be on **June 17, 2020 at 10:00 AM**.
