

Meeting Highlights

Executive Meeting of the Penticton Pickleball Club (PPC) Executive held on Wednesday, February 24, 2021

- The City is expected to install the sound barriers this spring and conduct follow up sound tests to measure effectiveness.
- The PPC will attempt to obtain an extension of playing time until 2:00 PM, from 1:00 PM, on Monday to Friday during the 2021 season.
- The Executive is hoping to have basic improvements to the courts (i.e. replacing the PVC gates, renumbering of the courts, seating, etc.) made in time for the potential May 1 opening of the season.
- Research into enhancements to the PPC website is ongoing.
- Initial plans are being made for the postponed 2020 AGM. It is uncertain if it will be an in-person or a virtual meeting.
- The Nominating Committee for the election of PPC officers has been set up, consisting of Gary Gierlich, Marty Lewis and Leo Gillich.
- The PPC has been set up on the Pickleball Canada National System (PCNS) and is awaiting an announcement of a go-live date for BC clubs.
- Each PPC member will be required to register and pay their Pickleball Canada and Pickleball BC fees on the PCNS website once it goes live.
- Details on accessing the PCNS website and registering for a PPC membership will be shared with members as soon as details are available.
- The PPC is hoping to begin its 2021 season May 1, however, that will depend on the level of COVID restrictions as that time approaches.
- The next PPC Executive meeting is planned for March 16, 2021.
