OUTBREAK PLAN – April 2021

Early detection and immediate implementation of enhanced cleaning measures are two of the most important factors in limiting the size and length of an outbreak. An “outbreak” is two or more cases; a “case” is a single case of COVID-19.

1. If a member/participant is suspected or confirmed to have COVID-19 they are to contact Vice President, Dave Burgoyne immediately. 250-770-9057. If unable to contact Dave, then contact the following:

2. If a member/participant reports they are suspected or confirmed to have COVID-19, and have been at the Pickleball Facility in the past 72 hours, the club will implement enhanced cleaning measures to reduce risk of transmission.

3. The PPC will implement our illness policy and advise members to:
 - a. Monitor their symptoms daily, use the BC COVID-19 Self-Assessment Tool (www.bc.thrive.health) to help determine if further assessment or testing is needed.
 - b. Members can contact 8-1-1 if further health advice is required or 9-1-1 if it is an emergency.

4. In the event of a suspected case or outbreak of influenza-like-illness, Dave Burgoyne or other executive member will:
 - a. immediately report and discuss the suspected outbreak with the Medical Health Officer (or delegate) at Interior Health (250-469-7070),
 - b. Call 8-1-1,
 - c. Implement the PPC Illness Policy, and enhanced cleaning measures.

5. If PPC is contacted by a medical health officer in the course of contact tracing, PPC will cooperate with local health authorities.
