

Meeting Highlights

Executive Meeting of the Penticton Pickleball Club (PPC)

Held on Tuesday, October 5, 2021

- As of September 30 the PPC had **217 members** and one life-time member.
- The program schedule for the 2022 season is expected to look similar to the 2021 schedule.
- Special thanks to Deb Wagar, Bob Beatty and Mark Hammerquist for their remarkable volunteer contributions to Club operations this season.
- A **scheduled learner's program** is planned for the 2022 season.
- Should pandemic restrictions allow, the Executive is optimistic **non-member guests will be welcome** to participate in the PPC drop-in program in the 2022 season.
- The Executive recommends an increase to \$10.00 per session for **non-member/guest drop-in fees**.
- The Executive recommends a **2022 membership fee of \$90.00 with a reduced fee of \$60.00 as of August 1**, until September 30, the end of the outdoor pickleball season.
- The PPC is optimistic the Club will have the opportunity to participate in the **National Coaches Certification Program**, which is led by Mark Renneson. Details TBA.
- The **Constitution and By-laws** are expected to undergo revisions over the winter months. One of the biggest changes is to add a non-voting position of 'Past President' to the Executive, in order to provide guidance and support to the incoming President and members of the Executive. Another change will be to identify some Executive positions which will be limited to a two-year term in order to promote continuity and stability.
