WEATHER PROCEDURES

1. Use your best judgement - if it is raining continuously you do not need to turn up at the courts.
2. If it has rained but doesn't look like it will rain again, it is your decision to go to the courts and use your best judgement on whether it is worth using the squeegees, blower, etc. to dry off the courts.
3. If it starts raining after you have arrived at the courts and it looks like it will continue to rain, lock the cabinet and the washroom before leaving.
4. If you do not know if you should stay or leave, it is better to err on the side of caution and cancel the session by informing members present that the session is "officially cancelled". Those members that wish to continue playing are then doing so as "public."

Safety:

Never play on a wet court. It is extremely dangerous.
